

# OSHA TIRE INFLATION SKILLS DEMONSTRATION FORM

Occupational Safety and Health Administration (OSHA) 29 CFR 1910.177 includes specific tire inflation equipment and safety requirements that apply when inflating C-Type light truck tires. In order to assist passenger and light truck tire service providers with compliance, each employee must demonstrate the ability to inflate a tire using the equipment and procedures contained in 1910.177.
