TIA's **200 Level Basic Earthmover Tire Service (ETS) Training Program** for OTR tire technicians outlines the minimum skills and safety guidelines for servicing one-piece, three-piece, five-piece, and double gutter OTR assemblies. The 3-hour video features 15 different modules that cover the basic safety guidelines for servicing OTR tires, wheels and rims in the field. Module 14 – Install & Remove Wheel Fitment

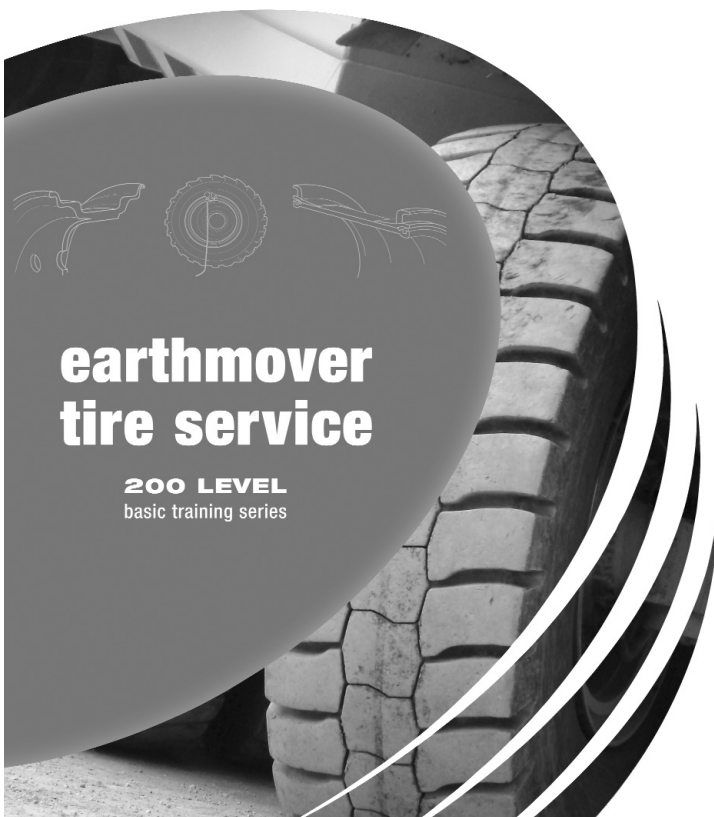
