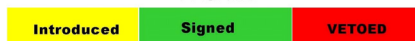

CO	SB 61	Inspections- currently, a motor vehicle that is being registered in the emissions program area for the first time is exempt from the requirement to get an emissions control inspection if the motor vehicle is in its fourth model year or newer. The bill extends the exemption period from 4 years to 10 years and expands its coverage to previously registered motor vehicles that have never failed an emissions control inspection. It also extends the exemption period for government-owned and dealer-owned vehicles to 10 years.
